Machine Learning and Artificial Intelligence

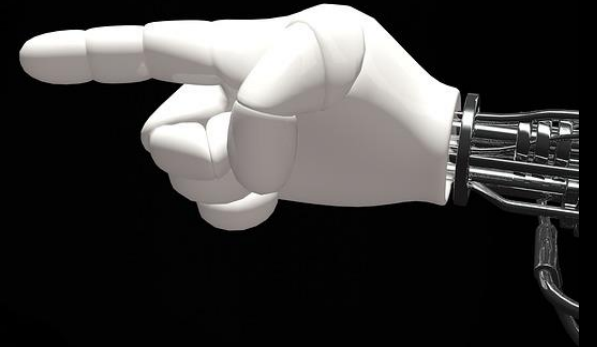

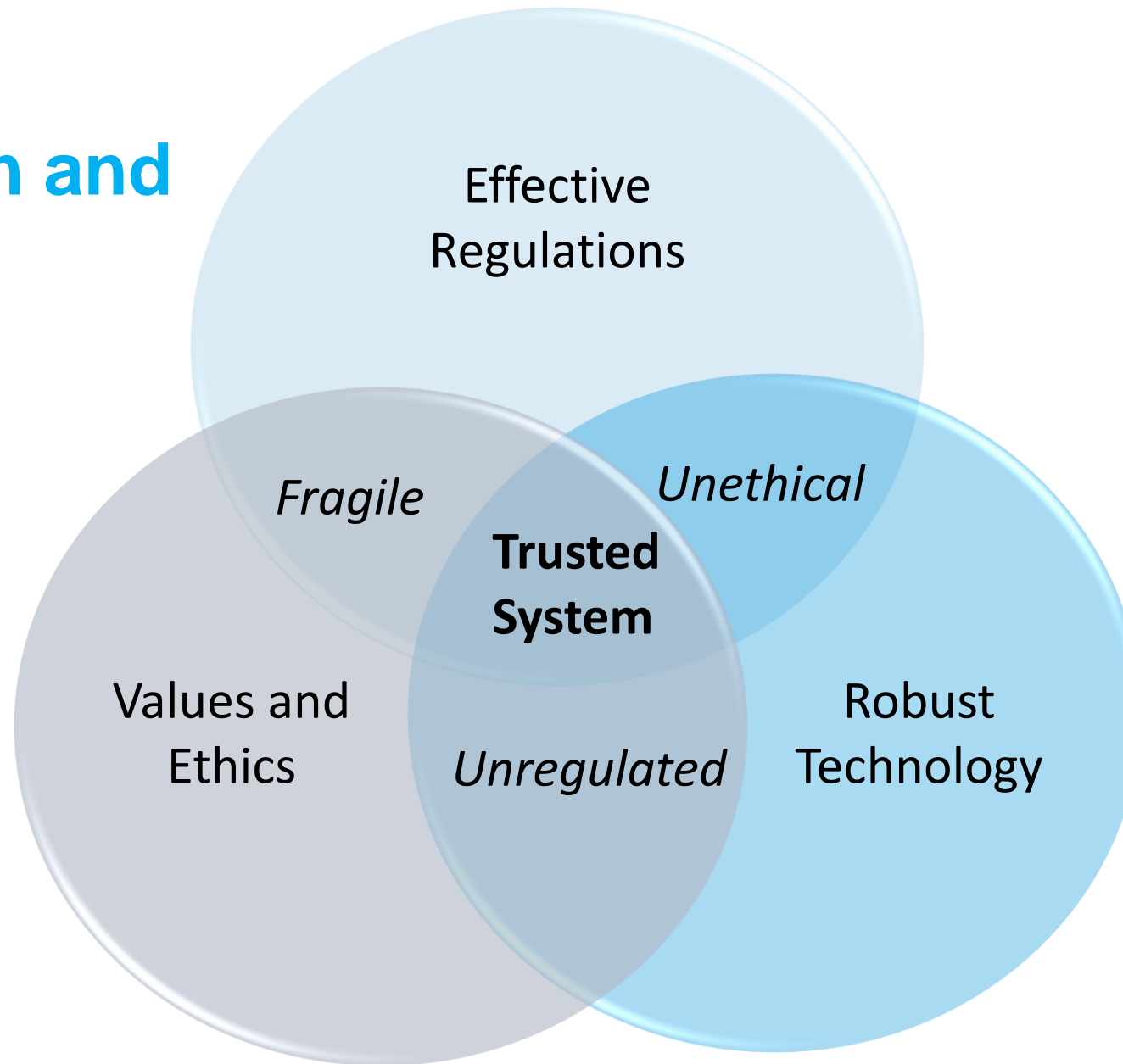
